The Wailea Gold Course Wailea's Rugged Beauty



The home course of the Wendy's Champions Skins Game, the Wailea Gold Course is the most challenging of Wailea's trio. Designed by Robert Trent Jones, Jr., it has been ranked among the country's best new courses by Golf Magazine and Golf Digest, and one of the world's best designed by the readers of Conde Nast Traveler.

Jones flavored the Gold with elements of classic golf course design, then finished it with a rugged, natural look. Throughout the course are stark lava rock outcroppings, indigenous Hawaiian grasses, an abundance of kiawe (a relative of mesquite), and remnants of papohaku, prehistoric lava rock walls built by early Hawaiians and preserved for their historic value.



The Gold's 200-foot elevation change from top to bottom enhances the numerous ocean and mountain vistas available from virtually every hole. The course has been labeled a "thinking player's" course because it demands strategy and careful club selection to be played well.

The Wailea Emerald Course

Wailea's Tropical Playground



Rated one of the best new courses by Golf Magazine and Golf Digest, as well as one of North America's most women-friendly by Golf for Women, the Wailea Emerald is akin to a lush tropical playground. Flowers bloom in great abundance: plumeria, bird of paradise, allamanda, gazenia, bougainvillea, beach morning glory, "firecracker" plants and more.

But don't be fooled by the Emerald's pleasant appearance. It is a superbly designed course created for pure golf enjoyment, regardless of one's handicap. Measuring 6,825 yards from the back,the Emerald features four to six tee boxes on every hole, allowing players to tailor the course to their playing level.



Notable features include a large double green shared by holes #10 and #17. Fronting the green is the only lake on the course. This is perhaps one of the Emerald's more picturesque spots.

The Wailea Blue Course The Grand Lady of Wailea



The first course ever built in Wailea, the stately Blue is a gracious resort course that has been ranked among America's best resort courses by Golf Digest. In its lifetime, it has hosted such prestigious events as the LPGA Women's Kemper Open and Japan's Asahi-Kyosen pro/celebrity golf tournament.

The Blue's fairways offer views of the ocean and Mt. Haleakala, and some of Wailea's stunning residential communities. It features several fountains and lakes, and an abundance of colorful hibiscus, wiliwili trees, bougainvillea and plumeria. The Blue was designed to appeal to a broad range of players. While it has challenged some of the finest professional players in the world, it also offers a measure of forgiveness in its wider fairways and large greens.




Like its sister courses, the worst hazards on the blue are the visual ones: the sapphire Pacific Ocean (where one can spot humpback whales during the winter months), several offshore islands, a volcanic cinder cone known as Pu'u Olai and majestic Mount Haleakala.



Pukalani Country Club



Set in the rolling hillsides of "up-country" Maui, Pukalani Country Club overlooks the Pacific Ocean and the rest of the Valley Isle of Maui from 1,100 foot level of Mount Haleakala, an extinct volcano whose name in Hawaiian means "House of the Rising Sun". Pukalani's 18 holes were designed by golf course architect Bob Balddock, and they cover nearly 160 acres. Built in 1970, the course is 6,962 yards long from the championship tees, plays to a par 72, and features 19 greens in its 18 hole layout!

Maui's only publicly-owned course, Waiehu Municipal Golf Course offers the spectacular views and challenging layout that one might only expect from a private course. Although it took more than 30 years to complete, the Waiehu course is one of the most popular municipal courses on any of the neighbor islands. The first nine holes, which first opened for play in 1930, are flat and run closely parallel to the palm-fringed beach along Kahului Bay. The second nine holes were not completed until 1966, and were constructed above the original nine on the slopes of the West Maui Mountains, which form the scenic backdrop of the course.

The par-72 18-hole layout measures 6,330 yards from the regular men's tees. Players will find the northeast trades to be a constant factor at the Waiehu golf course. It is located on Maui's north shore, which has the strongest and most consistent winds in the entire state of Hawaii. Along with the winds, players also have to take into account the 43 bunkers protecting the greens.

Tournament North Course-Main

Kaanapali's Tournament North Course opened its lush fairways in 1962 and is one of only two courses in Hawaii designed by the legendary architect Robert Trent Jones, Sr.

The Tournament course begins at sea level with a par 5 hole extending 550 yards. The course then curves upward and along the shore lines before winding its way to the West Maui Mountain foothills.

Stretching 6,994 yards, this par 71 course will challenge not only your ball positioning but putting skills as well.

Resort South Course- Main

The Resort South Course was originally created as an executive course and was later redesigned by architect Arthur Jack Snyder in 1976 to a par 71 course stretching 6,555 yards. With a combination of wide fairways and subtle greens, the Resort Course accommodates all levels of play.

This golf course land historically housed a sugar plantation and as you see the Sugar Cane Train steam past several holes on the course, (now used for tours) you are reminded of Hawaii's rich culture and history.

Along many holes on the Resort course lie natural canals, gulches and lava rock boundaries. Players will see native flowers along the course trails like the hibiscus, bougainvillea and plumeria, as well as the Cook and Norfolk Pines that line many fairways. These attributes are part of what makes the course so interesting and players extra cautious on windy days.








